Mrs. Auzina-Melalksne has international experience gained in the NASDAQ OMX group. Since 2003, she has been a member of the NASDAQ OMX Baltic Market Management Group, whose main responsibilities include the establishment and implementation of the Baltic securities market development strategy.
